Cincinnati ToolBank Hosts 5th Annual 'Banking on Our Community' Event

85+ volunteers completed projects at the Summit Center in Roselawn

CINCINNATI, OH (June 25, 2018) – Last Friday, June 22, the Cincinnati Community ToolBank hosted its fifth annual 'Banking on Our Community' volunteer event at the New Prospect Baptist Church, Summit Center in Roselawn.

As part of this unique event, four of the city's banks including Bank of America, First Financial Bank, PNC Bank, and US Bank as well as several of their clients came together to give back to the community. This year, volunteers assisted the Summit Center, acquired by the New Prospect Baptist Church in 2010. Volunteers utilized the Cincinnati ToolBank's inventory of tools and equipment to complete several facility improvements for the community center including demolishing 17+ shelters to make way for the facility's new "urban campground". Volunteers also repaired and painted the ceiling of two interior classrooms; and built dozens of bat boxes, constructed raised garden beds and much more.

"The Cincinnati Community ToolBank is proud to be a part of the Summit Center's revival efforts." says Kat Pepmeyer, Executive Director of the ToolBank. "This facility is such a big part of the Roselawn community and we hope that our efforts will go a long way in transforming the facility."
